## **GIRLS**

Girls usually have the option of either playing in a mixed team or a girl's-only team. Please let us know your preference on the registration form. Old Boys Collegians also has Youth grade teams, 1<sup>st</sup> grade and Premier team for secondary aged girls.

## **HELP REQUIRED – please tick Team Help**

Without voluntary help from you the parent's teams cannot be entered into the CICA competition. Old Boys Collegians Juniors are very fortunate to provide club coaches that take a training for players during the week for all grades. There is no requirement to help with coaching if you do not wish to.

The most important help that is required by parents is to act as managers for their child's team. The role is very small;

- Communication with myself and parents in the team.
- Saturday to co-ordinate who's doing what; gear bag, scoring, umpiring, team playing order etc. (Every parent has the responsibility of their child and so should be at games anyway and it's about everyone taking their turn. So the role of manager is a coordinator, not someone that does everything.)

This season New Zealand Cricket has introduced a Welfare of Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy, requiring that all our managers and coaches are police vetted and have completed the Child Protection module and Coaching module. This is to create an enjoyable and secure cricket environment for our children.

You will note the section on the registration form to tick. The more people that tick this box the easier the role of manager will be because it's shared. If you require more information about the role of a Junior Team manager please check the website for the job description. You will also note a Club help tick box, this is if you are able to help out with the general running of the club, fundraising, working bees, gear bags, administration etc.
